**Vacancy of Executive Board Member position in the
UEMS Multidisciplinary Joint Committee on Paediatric Urology (MJCPU)**

Dear colleague,

the UEMS Multidisciplinary Joint Committee on Paediatric Urology (MJCPU) was created in 2001 by the UEMS Sections of Paediatric Surgery and Urology together with the European Society of Paediatric Urology (ESPU).

All entering on the same level, the aims and motivations of the founding members of the MJCPU were (a) to create together a sort of syllabus of training in paediatric urology, looking carefully at its realisation particularly in regard to neonatal urology, (b) the need to have paediatric surgical and urological trainees exposed to adult urology, (c) the need that paediatric urology is organised and performed in an environment suitable for children's needs, such as a children's hospital, (d) the opportunity to have paediatric urology in the syllabus of the European Examination.

The MJCPU decided to create a Committee and an Academy in Paediatric Urology with functions parallel to those of Section and Board.

The Executive Board of the MJCPU is formed by two representatives from the Section of Paediatric Surgery (Jean-Michel Guys and Peter Vajda), two representatives from ESPU (Gillian Barker and Rafal Chrzan) and two from the Section of (adult) Urology (EBU) (Guy Bogaert and Josef Oswald).

With the departure of Jean-Michel Guys, the Executive Committee of the Section of Paediatric Surgery would like to inform you of the vacant position for a Board Member from our Section in the Executive Board of the MJCPU.

This vacant position is open to a paediatric surgeon, working in a paediatric surgical department, with experience and interest in paediatric urology (and with preferably a FEBPU title).

All interested candidates can send their candidature with letter of intention accompanied by curriculum vitae to Lucas Matthyssens, Secretary of the Section of Paediatric Surgery (Lucas.Matthyssens@uzgent.be) before the end of September 2023. The EC will then review and discuss all proposals received and select the best suitable candidate to represent the Section.
